We are looking for AA volunteers, women and men, to bring AA meetings into the jails in Multnomah County. We need volunteers who are interested in going to Inverness Jail, the Courthouse and the Justice Center.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Age 18 or older and a US citizen;
- 2 years of sobriety;
- No pending criminal court cases;
- No Class A: Felony convictions;
- Not incarcerated for a misdemeanor within the last 3 years;
- Not incarcerated for a felony with the last 5 years;
- Not currently or have been, within the last 3 years, under the supervision of any correctional, probation, parole, custodial treatment, pretrial or post-adjudication release program.
